

FLUSHING THE SYSTEM (flush tank attached)

To flush the system leaving the chemicals in the additive tank:

1. Turn the regulator valve off (clockwise), else water will flow into the chemical tank. (This should be off anyway for the control system to work properly).
2. Turn the three way tap under the tank to OFF (The middle position)
3. Turn the three way tap between the tank and the pump to the water tank direction.
4. Turn on the pump.
5. Run for at least 5 minutes through the spray nozzle.
6. Turn the pump off.
7. Turn the three way tap between the tank and the pump back towards the additive tank.
8. Leave the tap under the tank off until you are ready to use the system again.

To flush the system including the chemical tank:

1. Empty the chemical tank and fill with at least 5 litres of water.
Squirting around the sides of the tank to make sure it is clean.
2. Turn on the pump and empty the tank via the spray nozzle.
3. Turn the pump off, and also turn the tap under the chemical tank off.

FLUSHING THE SYSTEM (garden hose attached)

To flush the system leaving the chemicals in the additive tank:

9. Turn the regulator valve off (clockwise), else water will flow into the chemical tank. (This should be off anyway for the control system to work properly).
10. Connect a garden hose the flushing inlet of the three way tap between the tank and the pump.
11. Turn the three way tap under the tank to OFF (The middle position)
12. Turn the three way tap between the tank and the pump to the hose direction.
13. Turn on the pump and hose.
14. Run for at least 5 minutes through the spray nozzle.
15. Turn the pump off. Turn off the hose.
16. Turn the three way tap between the tank and the pump back towards the tank.
17. Leave the tap under the tank off until you are ready to use the system again.

To flush the system including the chemical tank:

4. Empty the chemical tank and fill with at least 5 litres of water.
Squirting around the sides of the tank to make sure it is clean.
5. Turn on the pump and empty the tank via the spray nozzle.
6. Turn the pump off, and also turn the tap under the chemical tank off.
